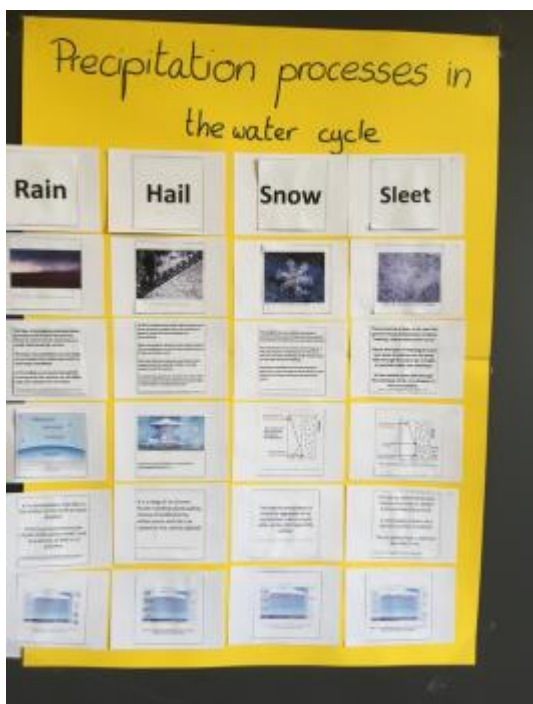
## **-Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> April 2017-**
