Tuesday,the 6th of may


Today we went in our Clil lessons.It was very exiting, we played games in a group to get to know each other, it was very funny. After this we learned about the history from the May Day.

After that we got a short break and time to perpetrate our presentations for the afternoon. When we were ready we went to a restaurant to eat pizza for lunch. It was very delicous.




