



Leer







It is an interesting museum which tells the visitors about the east Frisian tea culture and its history. The museum is located in the city Norden and it's an amazing place for a class/family trip. The children can find out everything about the history, do handicraft, paint, and draw, so there is no risk of boredom there. The costs for visiting the museum are cheap, so everyone can easily visit it. For adults the entry fee is: 6€

For children: 2€

For groups with up to 10 people: 4€

For a family: 12€

(The reduced price is: 4€)

Seasonal attractions

Gallimarkt

The Gallimarkt, which had its 500s anniversary in 2008, has been part of Leer in Ostfriesland since 1508. The Gallimarkt is the biggest and greatest folk festival in Ostfriesland. Every year nearly 500.000 people visit the Gallimarkt. You can get a lot of different things to eat or enjoy the funny attractions there.

Ice Skating

On the Holter Hammrich you can do ice skating in the winter. It is big fun and it is the biggest ice area in the region.

Neujahrskuchen

The "Neujahrskuchen", which is very tasty, is an old tradition of Ostfriesland. Every first day of the year, you eat the "Neujahrskuchen", which you have baked before, with your neighbors or family. It is a cookie dough that is put it into a waffle iron and then rolled up. You eat it with cream and a cup of tea.





Are you looking for a planned bike tour?



How about this one: A bike tour through "Landkreis Leer"

At first you can drive with your bike to the historic district of Leer, which is also called "das Tor Ostfrieslands". There are a lot of antique things and nice little shops. After that you can drive to the "Teemuseum", the entry fee for adults is 3,00€. You can buy some teacups and teas, but you can also enjoy a "Teezeremonie", which Ostfriesland is famous for. Ostfriesland is the largest tea consumer in the world. After that you can drive to the "Evenburg" in Leer, which was built in the middle of the 17th century. There is no entry fee for children! Then you can drive to the harbour in Leer, which has a very nice view and a lot of antique ships. The next place you can drive to is "Johnny's Kuhle", which is a fish pond. There is a beautiful landscape there. In the end you can drive to the "Hahnentanger Mühle", which is a mill that was built in 1864, where you can have an incredible guiding tour.
